These are times to consolidate progress on the right path and to reach environments that do not yet know Christ. It is our time and it is our opportunity to serve the Church through our Apostolate.



Message to the participants of the Cursillo de Cursillos held in Montevideo: I am very pleased to be able to address each of you, who are gathered during these days in the city of Montevideo, capital of the admired and beloved sister country of Uruguay, to live and celebrate this Cursillo de Cursillo "in the light of IF3", which summons the leaders of Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Paraguay and the host Uruguay, with the healthy intention of knowing, studying, assimilating and putting into practice in the different stages of the methodology and in the proper orientations in the actions of the Movement of the Cursillos de Cristiandad Movement in this region. of Latinamerica.

Both Mons. Faustino Armendáriz Jiménez, our Ecclesiastical Advisor and a servant, we regret not being with you. The MCC is an apostolic movement, inspired by God with the purpose of helping many to make their history a salvation story. Whatever the other objective, however noble it may be, betrays the identity of the Charism and therefore the will of God.

Reflection and spirituality



During the Meeting, Mons. Armendáriz begins this space of spirituality and reflection with the Lectio Divina: Christian happiness, an objective to promote and to reach in the OMCC (Mt 5, 1-12) and Lectio Divina: The OMCC mission: Carry the Word to all the peripheries! (Mt 4, 12-23)

In both participations before beginning the day's activities, they were an opportunity to listen carefully to the word of God and let God reach our hearts.

Lectio Divina: The OMCC mission: Bring the Word to all the peripheries! (Mt 4, 12-23):

In his message, Mons. Armendáriz leaves us the following words: We, cursillistas of today, have the joy of proclaiming and witnessing our faith, because there was that first announcement, because there were those humble and brave men who responded generously to the call of Jesus. On the shores of the lake, in an unthinkable land, the first community of disciples of Christ was born. May the awareness of these beginnings arouse in us the desire to bring the word, love and tenderness of Jesus to every context, even the most difficult and resilient. Bring the Word to all the peripheries! All spaces of human living are ground to which to throw the seeds of the Gospel, so that it may bear fruits of salvation.

And he concludes: Having heard: What moves me as a member of the OMCC to know and realize that this is the mission and method of Jesus?

Lectio Divina: Christian happiness an objective to promote and achieve in the OMCC (Mt 5, 1-12):

For fidelity to the Master. Given the forcefulness of Jesus' requests, it is our duty to accept and receive with sincere openness, that is, without comment, without elucubrations and excuses that take away their strength. The Lord made it clear to us that holiness cannot be understood or lived apart from these demands of his, because mercy is "the beating heart of the Gospel."

The objective of the OMCC will have to be illuminated with the light of this word in order to assume more and more sine glossa the charism that, as indicated by Fundamental Ideas 3: "The Cursillo charism is a gift that the Holy Spirit spills in his Church, which It forms a mentality and promotes an

ecclesial movement, which, through a kerigmatic method of its own, enables the experience and coexistence of the fundamental Christian, helps to discover and realize one's personal vocation and promotes groups of Christians who ferment the gospel environments, through of friendship. "

And he concludes: What do I commit to? What moves me as a member of the OMCC to know and realize that Christian happiness is an objective to promote and achieve in the OMCC?



During this day, the. Archbishop Mons Faustino Armendáriz J. Spiritual Adviser of the OMCC and Juan Adolfo Moguel Ortiz, President OMCC, met with the Cardinal of Chicago, Blase J. Cupich to discuss the MCC.






