When the Law of God, the law of love, is abandoned, "in the name of Christ we ask you to reconcile with God" (Co 5:20)

The Lord again grants us this year an auspicious time to prepare us to celebrate with the renewed heart the great Mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus, the foundation of the personal and community Christian life. We must continually return to this Mystery, with the mind and with the heart. In fact, this Mystery does not stop growing in us as we get involved in its spiritual dynamism and embrace it, responding freely and generously.

"Dear Amazonia" goes around the world





This Post-Synodal Apostolic Exhoration of the Holy Father Francisco, addressed to the people of God and to all people of good will, in which it is stated that: "... The Amazon is an interconnected plurinational totality, a great biome shared by nine countries: Brazil, Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Peru, Suriname, Venezuela and French Guiana. However, I address this Exhortation to everyone. On the one hand, I do it to help arouse affection and concern for this land that is also "ours" and invite them to admire it and recognize it as a sacred mystery; on the other hand, because the Church's attention to the problems of this place forces us to briefly resume some issues that we should not forget and that can inspire other regions of the earth to face their own challenges."

National Lay Congress 2020 in Spain



Pope Francis in a message sent to the Eminent Cardinal Ricardo Blázquez Pérez, President of the Spanish Episcopal Conference, said that: "... This teaches us - as the motto of the Congress affirms - that we are People of God, invited to live the faith, not of individually or in isolation, but in the community, as a people loved and loved by God. We belong to him, and this implies not only having been incorporated into Him through baptism, but living in coherence with that gift received. For this, it is essential to be aware that we are part of a Christian community. We are not one more group, nor an NGO, but the family of God summoned around the same Lord. Remembering this leads us to deepen our faith every day: a gift that is lived in the liturgical action, in the common prayer of the whole Church and that must be announced. It is the people called by God, who walks feeling the impulse of the Spirit, who renews him and makes him return to Him, again and again, to feel his own thing."




