We will celebrate 60 years of the English Speaking Cursillo in Australia at an Ultreya on Saturday evening. This is bound to be full of joy with witnessing by our friends from many of the other dioceses.

This Encounter will be a great opportunity to come together to renew ourselves and to help newer cursillists to go deeper and to understand more about our special Charism and purpose of the Movement, not just the weekend they attended.

#### Canberra/Goulburn

#### **Insurance**

Our Treasurer. Joe Jambor has been exploring how we might get a better deal with our insurance cover but in the short term has not been successful. Joe will renew our cover this month which will give us 12 months to look at other options

#### **APG**

The new system of affiliation fees to fund the activities of the OMCC & APG is in the process of being approved. The APG Executive is preparing their 2025 budget.

# **Fund Raising**

With the increase in the proposed fees needed to fund both the OMCC & APG and also the increase in our insurance premium there was a discussion at our Executive meeting on how we might increase our ability to meet these extra costs and to cover the requirements for our representatives travel costs both within Australia and overseas.

One suggestion was the running of a Silver Circle once or twice a year which could provide somewhere around \$2,000 per year. Another suggestion was to simply ask for donations as this has worked in some dioceses previously.

I would like your thoughts and suggestion on any other way this extra funding could be achieved.

#### **Promotion & Renewal of the Movement**

In the coming months I would like to begin discussions on how we might achieve the aim of how our Movement can be better recognised within our Church hierarchy and the wider Catholic community as a great tool for evangelisation. Not by what we say but the example of how we are living our faith life in all our environments.

Please continue to pray during 2025, not only for the National Encounter but for all our 3 day weekends and also for the evangelisation of our environments through Cursillo.
