Letter of the Holy Father to all the faithful for the month of May 2020

Dear brothers and sisters: May is approaching, in which the people of God express with particular intensity their love and devotion to the Virgin Mary. In this month, it is tradition to pray the Rosary at home, with the family. The restrictions of the pandemic have "forced" us to value this domestic dimension, also from a spiritual point of view. For this reason, I have thought to propose to all of us to rediscover the beauty of praying the Rosary at home during the month of May. Depending on the situation, you can choose to pray it together or personally, appreciating the good of both possibilities. But, in any case, there is a secret to do it: simplicity; and it is easy to find, even on the internet, good prayer schemes to follow. In addition, I offer two texts of prayers to Our Lady that you can recite at the end of the Rosary, and that I will say myself during the month of May, spiritually united to you. I attach them to this letter so that they are available to everyone. Dear brothers and sisters: Contemplating together the face of Christ with the heart of Mary, our Mother, will unite us even more as a spiritual family and will help us to overcome this test. I will pray for you, especially for those who suffer the most, and you, please, pray for me. I thank you and bless you from my heart.

Prayer 1

Assist the leaders of the nations to act with wisdom, diligence and generosity, helping those who lack what is necessary to live, planning far-reaching social and economic solutions and in a spirit of solidarity.


Holy Mary, touch consciences so that the large sums of money used in the increase and improvement of armaments are destined to promote adequate studies for the prevention of future similar catastrophes.
