Dear Presidents of International Groups, Cursillistas of the world:

The full summary of this meeting is included in this Newsletter.

It is important to note and remember the Bulletin published by Australia in October 2011 in a research paper carried out and signed by Mrs. Yvonne Carrigan, President of the OMCC, in which he pointed out the following:

“The content of this Bulletin will clear up many doubts in our presbytery and among our Cursillista brothers:

1. FEBA is a Foundation, which was established in 2000, while Eduardo Bonnin Aguiló was still alive.
2. This Foundation does not pursue profit, but rather to gather, safeguard, study and disseminate the mentality and writings of Eduardo Bonnin Aguiló.
3. FEBA, considers itself as: a) Servant to the International Cursillo Community and b) Center for dialogue, to share the ideals of Christ-Person-Friendship; and, to carefully preserve the values of the founding charism of the MCC ”.

The foregoing serves to record our willingness to dialogue and confirm that we are a Church Movement that fulfills its mission attached to Fundamental Ideas 3.

We continue in prayer and working on all the details to celebrate our VIII World Meeting to be held in October 2021, knowing that the MCC requires a human reality, a group of people to maintain its identity and fidelity in this world to which we are called. to evangelize in these times of change.

Some projects have been rescheduled due to the COVID-19 that affects humanity, however, we have continued working and living together using technology, since God planted us in this telematic era, and we must take advantage of it.

Together we are going along this path working to serve God, giving testimony of common union, the Lord has invited us so that his Voice may be heard and made present to show charity that the world needs today more than ever.

Dialogue MCC with the Eduardo Bonnin Aguiló Foundation.

With the purpose of knowing the functions, tasks and specific areas of competence in which the Eduardo Bonnin Aguiló Foundation (FEBA) carries out its activities and at the same time, share experiences, specify points of view, and establish the due attributions between said Civil Association and the Cursillos de Cristiandad Movement, on September 17, 2020, through the Zoom platform this OMCC Executive Committee, represented by Juan Adolfo Moguel Ortiz and Arz. Faustino Armendáriz Jiménez, we held a meeting promoted by the MCC International Groups: North America, Canada and the Caribbean (NACG) and the Latin American Group (GLCC), with Mr. Miguel Sureda, official representative of the aforementioned Foundation.

Mr. Miguel Sureda, in a correct and simple way, stated that the purpose and objective of the Foundation he represents is to preserve and disseminate the thought and works of layman Eduardo Bonnin; to offer his spiritual, intellectual and personal legacy: his writings, "scrolls", trips and interviews, in order to make his life and person known, thus making it possible for anyone interested in Eduardo's thought to know him, study him and share it, for which it has created among other things a web page, and a site on Facebook. Making the clarification that there are also other sites on the network that do not necessarily respond to the thinking and criteria of the Foundation, and therefore the Foundation cannot be held responsible for their content or comments.

Mr. Sureda emphatically clarified that because its client, the Eduardo Bonnin Foundation (FEBA), holds the civil association regime, it is not linked to the Catholic Church, nor is it part of any of the service structures of the Cursillo de Cristiandad Movement.

In this sense, Mr. Sureda wanted to make it very clear that the disagreements, confusion and deviations that have occurred previously in some leaders of the Movement and those that originate in the future, are completely beyond the responsibility of the group (FEBA) that he directs, being attributed in any case, to the personal responsibility of who, with his attitude or comment, causes an ideological conflict in the MCC.

Likewise, Mr. Sureda declared himself oblivious to other groups that have emerged with the same or similar intentions, specifically mentioning "the friends of the Charism".

In view of the affirmations made to Mr. Sureda that some people claim to belong to and in some cases act as local or regional representatives of said Foundation, they try to get involved in the Schools of leaders, in the diocesan and national Secretariats of the Movement, even that In certain Latin American countries they have established, subsidiaries or branches of the Civil Foundation (FEBA), with the purpose of disseminating either through Conferences, literature, slogans, proposals or comments, openly and definitely contrary to the Original Charism, to the Fundamental Ideas approved for the Movement in the VII World Meeting, as well as to the Legal Statute approved by the Holy See, in which in some cases, there have been personal attacks against some legitimate representatives of the Movement.

In this regard, Mr. Sureda, responded that the generation of FEBA subsidiaries or branches in some countries of America did not always obey the determinations of the civil Foundation based in Mallorca, but was the product of individual initiatives of people who linked or not to the FEBA association, they arose in a personal capacity, which in some cases was even unknown by said civil Foundation.

At the close of this meeting, Hugo Valverde, President of the Executive Committee of the NACCG, thanked the participants for having responded to the invitation to this dialogue in a Christian attitude, pointing out the importance of this gesture aimed at building unity in the MCC.


